## Useful Information③: How many kinds of Hanko(はんこ/判子)?



There is a tradition to use Hanko instead of sign here in Japan.

For example, Japanese people always use Hanko on the documents, official papers and etc. to show "I checked it." "I got it."

There are 3 kinds of Hanko in Japan.

1. Registered Seal 実印 (じついん) ・ ・ The officially registered seal. You use it for important forms and contracts, such as buying a car, house and etc.
2. Seal 認印 (みとめいん) ・ ・ Not registered seal. You use it on daily life, for example, when you receive delivery parcel and so on.
3. Bank Seal 銀行印 (ぎんこういん) ・ ・ The seal you need to open a new account in banks. Some people also use their registered seals or normal seals as their bank seals.

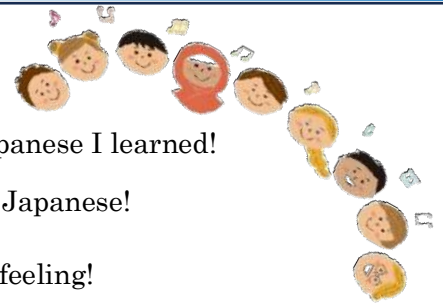
★ All the seals should be used carefully because each seal can be used as your own signature.
