Useful Information④ Minimum Wage

The Prime Minister Ishiba announced a goal to raise the minimum wage to
¥1,500 in the 2020s.

What is the Minimum Wage?

It is the smallest amount of money that an employer should legally pay a
worker for an hour of work.

The amount of money changes every year and varies by prefecture.

The newest minimum wage was changed last October.

The highest is ¥1,163 in Tokyo, ¥1,162 in Kanagawa, the lowest is ¥951 in
Akita. The amount of money is quite different.
